New Jersey Public Charter School Association to Host Press Conference Following High-Performing Charter School Expansion Denial

TRENTON, NJ - Feb. 23, 2022 - In response to the recent expansion denials of topperforming public charter schools, the New Jersey Public Charter Schools Association (NJPCSA) alongside parents and students from New Jersey's public charter schools will be hosting a press conference on Feb. 23, 2022 at 10 a.m. at Achievers Early College Prep Charter School to express their frustrations and concerns over these decisions. Governor Murphy and Acting Department of Education Commissioner Angelica Allen-McMillan, Ed.D. have recently denied expansion to top performing charter schools in Paterson, Newark and Trenton- mostly comprising students of color and low income populations. Many of these schools operated grade spans that these expansions would have allowed the students to remain at the school throughout their educational careers. With these denials, many parents are now having to find other schools for their children to attend and students will have to accustom to a new school environment midway through their education and during an ongoing pandemic.
