

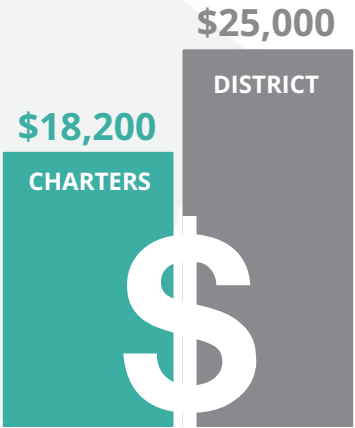

## Public Charter School Facts

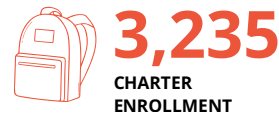

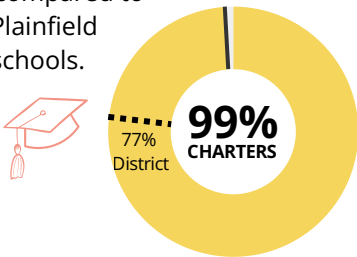

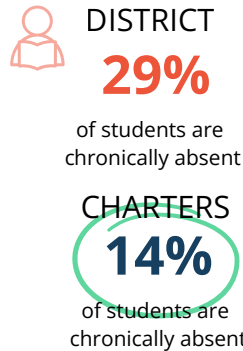

Plainfield public charter high schools are graduating **99%** of students within 4 years compared to **77%** in Plainfield district schools.

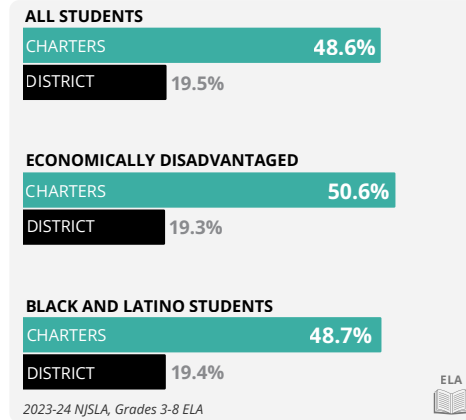

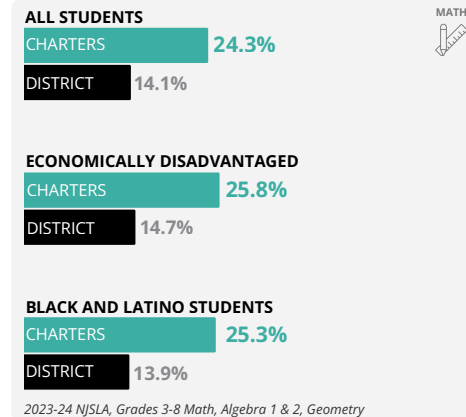
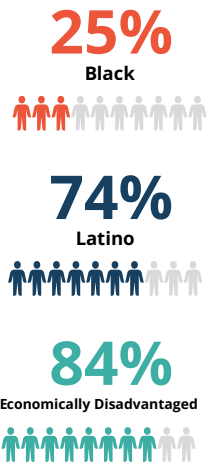
