



Plainfield charter school students outperform their district peers by 28 points in reading.

Charter schools in Plainfield receive \$7,000 less, per-pupil, than district schools.



Plainfield public charter high schools are graduating **96%** of students within 4 years compared to **75%** in Plainfield district schools.






